Are my kids allowed in the sanctuary?

We have designed our services to best minister to everyone at their level. Having found that children learn best in a classroom environment that is interactive and fun, the sanctuary is not the best place for them. *God is not boring and we never want kids to think that because they only experience church in an adult environment.* Additionally, teaching in the sanctuary is geared for adults and may contain important Biblical themes that are not appropriate for kids; *therefore, children under 10 are not permitted in the sanctuary during the message time.*

What about during worship?

During worship, newborns (0-18 mo) are permitted to be with parents in the sanctuary, but we ask that during announcements and message that children are taken to the Nursing Moms room or Nursery. *Our elementary kids LOVE to get the wiggles out during worship, so our classrooms provide the best environment for them to praise Jesus.*

Who will be watching my kids?

All of our teachers go through a thorough background check and interview process and are then trained to provide engaging, fun, Spirit-filled lessons to help your kids grow and become more like Jesus. Our nursery workers are warm and loving and provide a safe place for your infant or toddler.

What about our older kids?

Middle and high school students are with the adults in the sanctuary on Sundays. We also have student ministry specific to their age groups Wednesday nights at 7pm.
